

# Hotspot Lending Policy

1. The borrower must be a library patron 18 years or older with no overdue fines, lost items, or any other outstanding fines on their account.
2. Patron must have current address and phone number on file.
3. A Hotspot Lending Agreement must be signed in the presence of Library Staff each time a Hotspot is checked out.
4. Only **ONE (1)** Hotspot per household may be checked out at one time.
5. Hotspots will **DEACTIVATE** if not returned within **TWO (2)** days after the due date.
6. Hotspots must be returned to a Library Staff Member. **(Do not place in the Drop boxes!)**
7. All components of the Hotspot must be returned in working condition, including the device, charging block and cable, along with the case.
8. Patrons are responsible for Lost or damaged devices and components. Devices not returned within **ONE WEEK** of due date will be charged the full replacement cost of **\$120.00**. (Hotspot: \$80.00, Charger: \$20.00, Case: \$20.00)
9. Hotspots should be kept in a temperature controlled environment. **DO NOT** leave Hotspot in a hot or cold car.
10. Hotspot coverage is **NOT** guaranteed in all areas. The Hotspots run off of a Verizon signal.
11. Patron will agree to the Lawrence County Public Library's Internet and Wi-Fi Use Policy, wherein users are expected to use the Hotspot in a legal and responsible manner, consistent with the educational and informational purposes for which it is provided.
12. Patron should also be aware that the Hotspots do have content filtering.
